The Need

Articles 17(1) and 17(2)(a) of the õDirective regarding the certifications of persons and the certification registersö (RAD 174/2015) as amended in 2017, state that:

17(1) Persons registered in the public register shall be obliged to renew their registration in the public

register within two months from the end of each calendar year that follows their registration in the

public register.

17(2)(a) Persons registered in the public register shall be deemed to have renewed their registration when they

submit to the Commission a statement of continued professional training on topics that fall within the existing legislation on the capital market, of a duration of ten (10) hours for persons registered in the public register for the basic examination and of a duration of fifteen (15) hours for persons

registered in the public register for the advanced examination, for each calendar year.

The purpose of the above provision is to ensure that, the persons registered in the public register («certified persons») are informed of the legal framework, they are obliged to comply with, when they provide/carry out investment services/activities.

The Aim

To satisfy CySecos provision, for Continuing Professional Training, enabling CIFos employees to maintain their certification.

To expand the knowledge and competence of CIF as employees.

To answer and solve questions participants might have in the taught syllabus. In this respect:
